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## Scholarship Program

**Fundraising!** For the month of February, we are raising money for scholarships for the 2025-2026 school year. We would like to have more families attend Trinity if we can get a little help from you.

You can donate a monetary gift to help families that are struggling. Whether you donate \$5, \$10 or whatever you can to help us reach \$3000 for two children that can attend as half scholarships. The parents pay the other half. The cost of one child attending with half a scholarship is \$1,575.00. We would like to raise enough money each year for at least two or more scholarships to be added to the preschool budget.

We are grateful for the half scholarship support that our Church Elders give towards one child to attend from the community in sharing the love of Jesus. An envelope will be provided to express the love you have for Trinity Lutheran Preschool.

**Themes!** Themes for the month of February are

Hygiene, Dental and Health. Preschoolers will learn the importance of keeping their body clean every day and include washing their hands after using the restroom. Along with the hygiene lessons they will learn the importance of brushing and flossing their teeth and covering their mouths and noses with a tissue when sneezing or coughing. Also washing hands after handling pets or other animals.

They will learn the proper nutrition and how exercise can keep you healthy. Teachers will talk to the children about health items such as soap, combs, brushes, toothpaste, toothbrushes and many more items that will keep you healthy.

Potty training is possible if the teacher and parents work together. For the ones that are not potty trained this would be a great time to start. Talk to your child's teacher and between the both of you working towards this goal your child will be ready for the three-year-old class next year.

Please work with your child at home supervising them to take down their own bottoms and get themselves onto the toilet, wipe, flush and pull up their own bottoms. By working together, let's make this our goal for them to potty without assistance.

Fall registration will begin Friday, February 28<sup>th</sup> and end on Monday, March 31<sup>st</sup> for the families that are enrolled in the program now and the community! This is giving you the first chance to enroll your child for the 2025-2026 school year at a reduced non-refundable registration fee price of \$85.00 instead of \$125.00.

Registration will be opened to the community for the 2025-2026 school year at the same time as for the families already enrolled in the program with a non-refundable registration fee price of \$95.00 instead of \$125.00. April 1, 2024, registration fee will be \$125.00 for the 2025-2026 school year.

Registration packets will be ready for you to pick up on Friday, February 28<sup>th</sup> in the preschool office. This will be a first come first basis for enrollment. Please spread the word about fall registration for the 2025-2026 school year.
