Fall Pre-registration for 2025-2026 school year begins March 1st and ends March 31st. Pre-registration is open for the preschool families that are currently in the program as of now, AND to new students from the community that are not enrolled.

The non-refundable pre-registration fee for Trinity Lutheran Preschool is \$95.00 for students new to the school and \$85.00 for students currently enrolled.

For the month of March ONLY, fall registration will be at a reduced price for both the families

enrolled now and for the community. Once April 1st arrives registration will revert to the regular price of \$125.00 for students new to the school.

Registration packets are ready for you to pick up in the preschool office. If you are planning to have your child attend Trinity, please come by the office and pick up a packet, fill out enrollment forms and return the packet with the registration fee before Sunday, March 31st.

Preschool is closed Friday, March 7th which is before spring break and Monday, March 17th after spring break.

Drop Off! We are asking all parents to please, please drop off your child and leave so the teacher can begin their class. The longer you stay it delays the classes' routine and consistency. Between you and the teacher, consistency is one of the most important routines in a child's life.

The Children will continue to learn the letters for the month B, V, W, E and K. The shape and color for the month is CRESENT and ORANGE.

The Bible verse for the month is: "He is Risen". (Mark 16:6). The children will learn The Nineth Commandment: You shall not covet your neighbor's house. *What does this mean?* We should fear and love God so that we do not scheme to get our neighbor's inheritance or house or get it in a way which only appears right but help and be of service to him in keeping it.

The children will learn The Tenth Commandment: You shall not covet your neighbor's wife, worker, or animals. *What does this mean?*

We should fear and love God so that we do not entice or force away our neighbor's wife, workers, or animals, or turn them against him, but urge them to stay and do their duty.
