

Old Business:

Barry Wolf presented a bid of approximately \$7,600.00 for a new PGF laser projector, including installation, supplies, scaffolding and electricity connection, to be installed in the gym for use by the preschool and church. Terry Hankins made a motion to accept the bid for the new projector. Ruth Szymanski seconded the motion. All Council members approved, and the motion passed.

May Report - As of May 31, 2024, the cash balance in the General Fund was \$31,836.40. The Building Fund balance was \$40,784.10 and the Designated Fund balance was \$98,915.85. The Total of All Funds was \$171,536.35. The total contributions for May were \$27,156.07 and total expenses for May were

\$20,493.25. The total contributions for the year 2024 were \$121,729.87 while the total expenses for the year were \$111,072.93.
