Reminder..... You can set up your offerings/tithes to happen automatically. It's a very simple process. All you need is a checking account. Then you choose the amount, the date and the frequency of your offering. You can set it up weekly, monthly, bi-monthly, whatever you prefer. The amount and date will stay the same until you request for it to be changed. A monthly report is generated so that you will still receive

credit for tax purposes. If interested, all you need to do is complete a short, one page form. The Church Treasurer inputs the data. There is no charge to you or to the Church. This is a free service offered by Citizens State Bank. We have been using this system for almost 18 months, without any problems. ## **Holy Communion**

All who commune today are encouraged to prepare themselves by using the "Christian Questions with Their Answers" section of Luther's Small Catechism found on page 329 of the hymnal. As a congregation of the Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod, we celebrate communion believing that we receive the true body and true blood of Christ for the forgiveness of sins and the strengthening of faith. As such, we invite all to our altar who share our belief and teaching concerning the Lord's Supper. All are welcome to commune who:

Are Baptized Christians

Able to properly examine themselves recognizing their sinfulness

Believe that they are eating and drinking Christ's body and blood

Believe they need what is offered in this sacrament, namely the forgiveness of sin, the strengthening of faith, and the power to lead a godly life. Ephesians 4:22-24

If you are unsure of any of these points or have questions, please speak with the Pastor or an Elder. Those who wish to participate in the Lord's Supper at TLC are requested to register by circling their name(s) on the communion card in order that their participation in the Lord's Supper is properly recorded. Individual cups containing grape juice are placed at the center of the tray for those who are sensitive to alcohol. Children and others not communing are invited to come to the altar to receive a blessing, indicate your desire to receive a blessing by crossing your arms over your chest.

During communion if you are not able to come to communion rail, you may remain at your pew and inform the Usher that you would like to receive communion at your seat.

Church office hours are 8-3 Monday through Thursday, and Friday until **Stewardship** noon. Offerings may be dropped off or mailed to 402 Atchison, Sealy, TX 77474.
