"I Am the Resurrection and the Life"

In the nineteenth century the Russian forces attempted to gain land in the eastern Mediterranean. This sparked the Crimean War of 1853-1856 when the United Kingdom, France, and Sardonia fought against the Russian expansion.

During this war, at the battle of Inkerman in 1854 a soldier was struck down. He was just able to crawl back to his tent. When his fellow soldiers found him, he was lying face down. His Bible was open before him and his hand was set inside the Bible along with his blood covering it. When his hand was lifted, the letters of the page were clear with the ever-living promise of John 11:

Jesus said, "I am the resurrection and the life; he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live."

We may not be in an actual bloody battle or in a warlike situation such as this soldier, but those words should ever be set in our hearts forever. Jesus reminds us that He is our resurrection and our life. We have been baptized into His death and resurrection, so we also share in His eternal life.

Potty Training! I want to remind the two-Potty Training year-old parents that all who are going into

the three-year-old class this fall must be potty trained. Please remember that if your child is not potty trained, they may not be in the three-yearold class. That means no pull ups! Each child must be in underwear or panties!

Please work with your child at home supervising them to take down their own bottoms and get themselves onto the toilet, wipe, flush and pull up their own bottoms. By working together, let's make this our goal for them to potty without assistance.

Potty training is possible if the teacher and parents work together. I appreciate all the parents supporting the teacher for potty training the children.

If your child has been sent home with a change of clothes from Trinity, please return it by the end of this school year.

If you have bottoms like panties for girls or underwear for boys, socks, stretch shorts or pants and you are no longer in need of them, you can donate them to preschool.
